Employment (including bullying, harassment, grievance, performance and flexible working):

- Performance related disciplinary matter involving director and senior manager

- Director level disputes including dispute between 19 Directors of a company about governance and the viability of increasing the revenue of the company from £55 million to a potential £100 million and/or facing dissolution.

Property Disputes including:

Contractual claims including:

- Breach of contract claim brought by charterer and agent of South African shipping manufacturer

Professional negligence claims including:

- Claim against financial advisor for loss of opportunity to purchase a property
- Claim brought by client against solicitor

Insurance claims: including claim where car reclaimed by insurance company went missing

Inheritance Act Disputes including:

- Claim against the estate brought by children of intestate;
- Claim brought by parents of deceased against spouse and solicitors of deceased.

Neighbourhood disputes involving noise, violence and mental health issues (not available through Consensus Mediation, but call for information).
